

Very Special Arts Festival Volunteer Information



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

PARKING - You may park in the Museum's two parking lots and on the surrounding streets. Do not park in the Red Cross parking lot. Parking is limited, so carpool if possible. We know parking becomes difficult, so plan to arrive early enough to find parking and be ready for Orientation at 8:30.

CHECK-IN - It is at 8 AM. Enter through the front doors. You will be directed to the check-in tables. You will receive your daily assignment and a volunteer t-shirt. Coffee will be provided.

ORIENTATION - It is at 8:30 AM and is mandatory. You will report to your assigned station at 9 AM for further instructions on your art project/assigned task.

LUNCH - Lunch is provided for you at the end of your shift.

STAFF - Staff will be wearing red museum t-shirts. There will also be a nurse on duty for any emergencies.

TIPS - Dress appropriately. If you are outside, wear a hat and sunscreen. Water will be available. Be sure to eat breakfast before you come to last until lunch. Wear clothes that you don't mind getting paint and clay on. You will be provided a volunteer t-shirt to wear for the day.
