WOMEN OF VISION TAXIS

\$100 each

The Women of Vision Program is one of the longest running art programs for the visually impaired in U.S. museums. This is a unique initiative that brings the visual and literary arts to adults who are blind or visually impaired by providing integrated arts education workshops. Because of visual impairment transportation for these participants is by taxi.

The annual VSA Festival offers students with disabilities the opportunity to experience art-making surrounded by original works of art.
